LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

What a wonderful 50th anniversary year 2021 proved to be! Yes, the world was still challenged by a global pandemic, and no, we couldn't celebrate the anniversary in exactly the way we had hoped. And yet, God showed up in tremendous ways as we marked the significant milestones achieved since WME was founded in 1971, including the celebration of the 25th anniversary of both the Order of the FLAME and the first publication of the Faith-Sharing New Testament with the Psalms.

Having shifted in 2020 to digital avenues for training and developing resources, 2021 saw us continuing our work to connect and equip the global Wesleyan family in mission and evangelism through a wide variety of means, from podcasts to webinars. Additionally, our anniversary year provided the opportunity to introduce several new resources, which are already showing great impact.

The first was the release of an Anniversary Edition of the Faith-Sharing New Testament with the Psalms. This updated and expanded edition draws on the strengths of the original while offering additional insight for our current age. We also created a set of short videos called Plain Truth, as a companion to the "Basics of Christian Faith" section of the FSNT. The second resource was an additional set of teaching videos to accompany Embrace: Showing and Sharing the Love of Jesus. Each of these downloadable, 20-minute videos provide expanded teaching for the six sessions of Embrace and are excellent for small group use. You can find them, along with all WME's resources at our online store.

As all of us deal with the prolonged nature of the pandemic, we remain deeply grateful for the faithful giving that has not only sustained our work but allowed us to expand it for sake of the kingdom. God is indeed steadfast and continues to provide opportunities for creative ministry. For our part, we stand ready to follow where he leads as we empower Christ followers to share the good news of Jesus Christ.



July 26, 1938 - July 28, 2021

The Rev. Dr. H. Eddie Fox passed away July 28, 2021 in Sevierville, Tennessee. For twenty-five years Eddie served as World Director of World Methodist Evangelism, traveling the world inspiring thousands of Christian leaders to share the Gospel story so that the world might know Jesus Christ.


