

PRAY WITH US

Prayer is the foundation of any movement of the Spirit. As we prepare for **World Evangelism Sunday**, we invite you and your congregation to join in a shared commitment to prayer—before, during, and after June 8.

Use the prompts below as part of your worship, small groups, or personal devotion.

Before World Evangelism Sunday (Now through June 7)

1. Pray for readiness.

“Lord, prepare our hearts to hear Your voice and respond in obedience. Soften us to the leading of Your Spirit and open our eyes to those who need Your love.”

2. Pray for boldness in witness.

“Holy Spirit, give us courage to share our faith in both word and action. Let us not be ashamed of the gospel, but speak with joy and compassion.”

3. Pray for unity across the Church.

“God, thank You for the global Wesleyan Methodist family. As we prepare to worship together on June 8, unite us in mission, in purpose, and in love.”

4. Pray for the resources to reach those who are unreached.

“Jesus, provide what is needed—people, time, finances, and vision—for churches around the world to carry the gospel to new places and new hearts.”

On World Evangelism Sunday (June 8, 2025)

5. Pray for a global harvest.

“Lord of the harvest, we ask for a fresh

outpouring of Your Spirit. As Your word is preached today around the world, may many come to know You.”

6. Pray for transformation.

“God, let this day not be an event, but a spark. Transform hearts, congregations, and communities to live on mission every day.”

7. Pray for generosity.

“Jesus, move us to give joyfully and sacrificially. Use every gift to multiply the impact of the gospel through World Methodist Evangelism and the churches we serve.”

After World Evangelism Sunday (June 9 and beyond)

8. Pray for lasting fruit.

“Lord, may seeds planted today grow into lives changed, leaders raised up, and communities transformed by Your love.”

9. Pray for follow-through.

“Help us not to forget or move on too quickly. Show us how to keep living out the mission to share our faith and make disciples.”

10. Pray for continued connection.

“Keep us connected to the global Church. Remind us that we are part of a larger story—Your story of redemption in every culture, language, and nation.”

Bonus Idea: Consider inviting your church to dedicate a short time of prayer during worship or in small groups each week leading up to June 8. You might also include these prompts in your church newsletter, social media, or a 5-minute pre-service prayer moment.
